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Vendor Event Information

- Please fill out vendor registration completely.
- Vendor Village setup opens at 6:00am and must be completed by 7:15am. No exceptions.
- All vendor location requests will be considered on a first come - first serve basis.
- Vendors must provide your own tables, table covers, chairs, etc. Space provided is 10x10.
- Electricity will not be available and no generators allowed.
- Vehicles will not be allowed in the festival area after 7:15am. with the exception of emergency and security vehicles. For safety reasons, all vehicles must be removed from festival grounds by 7:15am. No exceptions.
- Vehicle passes will be provided at check-in for the designated Vendor parking area.
- Booths must be completely set-up by 7:15 a.m. Booth setup will re-open for 30 minutes after all cyclists have left the grounds. The festival requests that all vendor booths remain open until 2:00p.m.
- The Festival officially opens at 9:00am after all bicyclists have left the grounds to begin the Tour de Plantersville. The Festival ends at 2:00pm. Vendors will have from 2-4pm to breakdown.
- To prevent accident or injury, any vendor wishing to leave early **MUST** notify a festival official. With permission, booths that can be packed-up and “walked-out” will be allowed to do so. No vehicles will be allowed on the festival grounds before 2:00p.m., without the permission and escort of a festival official.
- The vendor is responsible for leaving the vendor area in the condition that it was originally received, i.e. removal of all debris such as boxes and trash. Designated trash areas will be indicated at check-in.
- Each vendor will receive a confirmation letter upon receipt of their application and payment.
- **Due to COVID-19, CDC health and safety measures will be followed. All registered vendors will be notified by email and updates will be distributed through our media outreach.**
- This event occurs rain or shine! Be prepared for wind, rain and/or temperature fluctuations.
- All vendor fees are non-refundable.
- All vendors are required to show proof of liability insurance. If this is an issue, please contact us before October 11, 2021 at 843-318-8644 or Marilyn@GullahGeecheeChamber.org.
- Absolutely no unattended vehicles may be left on the festival grounds the night before or after the festival.
- Vendor Applications with payment must be postmarked to the Gullah Geechee Chamber of Commerce by Monday, October 11, 2021.
- Taxes and fees are the responsibility of the vendor.
